## Try to Turn Every Situation into a Win-Win

You are going to deal with adverse situations at work. It's a fact of life. This could be as simple as asking if the person has something they want to talk about. Even just showing that you are willing to do this can go a long way to diffuse the situation.

You could proceed to offer to take on some of the person's workload if that is what they are struggling with. Just make it clear that you will only do this for a short period of time, with the understanding that they need to take up the duties after such a time.

If the situation is work related, try to work with the person to find a solution that will help them solve it. This will take some time out of your day but having the person return to a good place is going to make this extra time worth it.

Of course, there are going to be people that no matter how much effort you put in to try and help, are going to be adversarial towards you. If they continue to do so in a manner that is not within their right, you will need to figure out whether you want to escalate the situation with your manager. This should be the last course of action but may be necessary. You will likely find that most people will be receptive when they see that you both come out as winners.
